

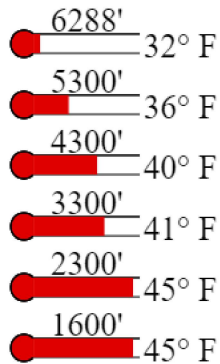

HIGHER SUMMITS FORECAST

Mountain weather is subject to rapid changes and extreme conditions. This outlook is just one tool to help you plan a safe trip. Always travel with adequate clothing, shelter, food and water, and make your own assessment of weather conditions.

Friday

Mostly in the clouds under mostly cloudy skies w/ a wintry mix transitioning to rain. Scattered afternoon thunderstorms. Little to no additional snow and sleet accumulations. Some thunderstorms could provide heavy rain, hail, or strong winds.

Temperature (°F): Upper 30s
Winds: Light and variable becoming W at 5-20 mph
Wind Chill (°F): 25 to 35 above

Friday Night

In the clouds w/ rain showers likely and a slight chance of a wintry mix late. Chance of thunderstorms early. Little to no snow accumulations.

Temperature (°F): Lower 30s
Winds: W shifting NW at 5-20 mph, increasing to 15-30 mph
Wind Chill (°F): Falling to 15 to 25 above

Saturday

In and out of the clouds under mostly cloudy skies w/ rain showers. Slight chance of afternoon thunderstorms.

Temperature (°F): Lower 40s
Winds: NW at 15-30 mph, increasing to 20-35 mph
Wind Chill (°F): 15 to 25 above then rising

Saturday Night

In and out of the clouds under mostly cloudy skies w/ a chance of rain showers.

Temperature (°F): Mid 30s
Winds: NW at 20-35 mph w/ gusts up to 40 mph
Wind Chill (°F): Falling to 20 to 30 above

MOUNT WASHINGTON VALLEY REGIONAL FORECAST

Friday

Patchy fog this morning. Cloudy w/ a chance of rain showers. A chance of afternoon thunderstorms. Some thunderstorms may produce heavy rainfall or small hail this afternoon.

Temperature (°F): Lower 60s
Winds: Light and variable

Friday Night

Mostly cloudy w/ a chance of rain showers. A chance of thunderstorms early. Patchy fog late. Some thunderstorms may produce small hail early.

Temperature (°F): Upper 40s
Winds: Light and variable

Saturday

Patchy morning fog. Partly sunny w/ a chance of rain showers and a slight chance of thunderstorms in the morning, then mostly cloudy w/ rain showers likely and a chance of thunderstorms in the afternoon.

Temperature (°F): Lower 60s
Winds: Light and variable

Saturday Night

Partly cloudy. A chance of rain showers early.

Temperature (°F): Upper 40s
Winds: Light and variable
